


Voice of the Veteran





The VA Blue Button enables Veterans to view, print and download an electronic file (.txt, .PDF, or .bluebutton) that contains their available personal health information from My Health eVet



VA Blue Button: VA Continuity of Care Document (VA CCD)

VA Continuity of Care Document*

*Requires Authentication ion

- Contains essential health and medical care information in an XML file format that uses recognized standards for interoperability
- Can support the exchange of information between health care providers for the effective continued care of the patient
- Can be viewed by health care systems and providers who have the capability to read or process an XML file, or imported into other applications

Self entry information available immediately, many other VistA extracts are available.




Holds:

- •VA pathology has a 14 day hold
- •7 day hold for data classes: VA Notes, VA labs, VA Radiology, VA Discharge Summary
- Move towards 3 day (meaningful use)
